第 56 回 ISU 通常総会, ドゥブロヴニク, 2016 年 6 月 緊急議題

セクション VII 組織規程に関する手続条項パート A 総会-組織の第 29 条第 5 項によれば, 組織規程, その手続条項, または一般規程及び特別規程に対する提案が 12 月 1 日以降に提出された場合, 提案が ISU 事務局に全ての会員に配布できるよう英語で, 総会の 3 週間前までに提出され, 総会に出席し投票に参加した会員の 5 分の 4 以上の多数により緊急性があると認められた場合には, 総会で議論され採決される。

一般規程

緊急提案 第 1 番

英国

規則 107 条第 1 項 j), ISU 選手権大会と国際大会の定義

全ての付随する変更と共に以下のように変更する:

j) 世界ジュニアシンクロナイズドスケート選手権 (隔年, 2012/13 年シーズンから始まる)

理由: 毎年開催されるとする他のスケート種目と合わせるため。

予算: この選手権大会に対する ISU の **118,000 米ドル** の資金的貢献。加えて, ISU はキャンセル/債務保証, 基本的な結果に関するサービスとメダルも負担する。ISU コーディネータ(大会コーディネータまたは地域イベントコーディネータ)1 名だけが参加する。旅費, 宿泊費及び食費については, 規則第 137 条第 9 項の e), f), 第 137 条第 10 項 b), c), e), h), 規則第 137 条第 12 項及び規則第 137 条第 15 項 b),c)が適用される。

緊急提案 第 2 番

英国

規則 128 条第 9 項, 選手権大会の順序

全ての付随する変更と共に以下のように変更する:

9. 世界ジュニアシンクロナイズドスケート選手権(隔年, 2012/13 年シーズンから始まる)は 3 月第 1 週より早く開催されてはならない。

理由: 毎年開催されるとする他のスケート種目と合わせるため。

予算: この選手権大会に対する ISU の **118,000 米ドル** の資金的貢献。加えて, ISU はキャンセル/債務保証, 基本的な結果に関するサービスとメダルも負担する。ISU コーディネータ(大会コーディネータまたは地域イベントコーディネータ)1 名だけが参加する。旅費, 宿泊費及び食費については, 規則第 137 条第 9 項の e), f), 第 137 条第 10 項 b), c), e), h), 規則第 137 条第 12 項及び規則第 137 条第 15 項 b),c)が適用される。

SPECIAL REGULATIONS SPEED SKATING

Urgent Proposal No. 3 (amendment of Proposal No. 124)

SPEED SKATING TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

Rule 208, paragraph 5

Amend as follows:

5. a) The maximum number of Competitors in the single distance events and team events of the European Championships are the same as the maximum number of Competitors for the same events in the World Single Distances Championships, see Rule 208, paragraphs 3b). For the Allround Championships event and the Sprint Championship event the maximum number of participants in each of the events is 24 Men and 20 Ladies.

b) The maximum number of Competitors from one ISU Member in each event of the European Championships is the same as the maximum number of Competitors for the same events in World Championships, see Rule 208, paragraphs 3a), 4a) and 6a).

c) Entry quotas for each event will be allocated to European ISU Members according to a qualification system with the same structure as the system applied for the corresponding events in World Championships, see Rule 208, paragraphs 3, 4 and 6. Further details, including information on the designated qualifying competitions and qualifying times, will be announced in an annual ISU Communication. For the first edition of the European Sprint Championships event pre-allocation of quota places will be based on the top 20 results from the preceding World Sprint Championships.

d) When the Championships are organized in the format with single distances and team events program, the maximum number of entries for an ISU Member will be 10 Skaters per gender in total.

e) Each ISU Member may enter a maximum of one (1) substitute for each event.

Reason: This urgent matter proposal adds some necessary details and clarification to Proposal No. 124, and it is worded so that it can replace this proposal in the Congress agenda. The proposal addresses the implementation of new format proposed for the European Championships (Proposal No. 112), which is linked to Proposal No. 83 introducing an alternating schedule of the World Championships.

Proposal No. 124 lacked some details to be complete. Using the same type of qualification system as for the corresponding World Championships, based on World Cup results, will require some adjustments and clarifications. This is because the European Championships will be scheduled earlier in the season and be held in alternating seasons with the corresponding World Championships. Therefore the qualification process cannot use the same World Cup competitions as used for the World Championships. It is also necessary to include specific rules on the quota qualification basis for the first edition of the Sprint Championships.

After a careful review of European participation in recent ISU Championships, it appears that it would be more adequate to use the same upper limit on the number of participants in the Allround Combination and the Sprint Combination. Holding the Sprint and the Allround Championships during the same Event will restrict a bit the number of female skaters available, since combining allround and sprint is very unusual for Men, but more common for Ladies. It is therefore reasonable to set the limit of participants for Ladies a little lower than for Men. This will give a comparable situation between Ladies and Men in the level of competition for qualifying quota places for the respective Championships events. This is the same approach as used for quota places at the Olympic Winter Games.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS SHORT TRACK SPEED SKATING

Urgent Proposal No. 4

NETHERLANDS

Rule 281, paragraph 2.a)

Add sentence as follows:

Each Member has the right to enter one (1) Competitor in each category. If a Member had one Skater amongst the best 32 Competitors in the final classification of the same preceding Championships that Member may enter two (2) Competitors in total in the respective category. If a Member had more than one Skater amongst the best 16 Competitors in the final classification of the same preceding Championships of which one or more scored Final Points that Member may enter 3 Competitors in total in the respective category. The host country is entitled to enter 3 Competitors in total in each category (though the minimum qualifying times as stated below do apply to the host country as well);

Minimum qualifying times are required for entry in this ISU Championship. The required qualifying times, the qualifying period, the category of competitions and other conditions under which the times must have been achieved, are decided by the Short Track Speed Skating Technical Committee and will be announced in an ISU Communication. The ISU Members are responsible to submit verification of the best qualifying time achieved by each Competitor entered for the ISU Championship. If sufficient verification is missing, the entry will not be accepted.

Reason: When the maximum number of skaters (3) from the organizing nation may always compete on the individual distances, this could have a positive effect on the attention and popularity of short track in the host country. The Relay competition already has a regulation to the benefit of the host country; this proposal expands this regulation to the individual distances.

NB. This proposal does NOT affect the number of starting positions of other nations. The starting positions for the skaters of the host nation will be additional.

Urgent Proposal No. 5

NETHERLANDS

Rule 285, paragraph 2.a)

Add sentence as follows:

Each European Member has the right to enter one (1) Competitor in each category.

If a European Member had one Skater amongst the best 32 Competitors in the final classification of the same preceding Championships that Member may enter two (2) Competitors in total in the respective category. If a European Member had one or more Skaters among the best 8 Competitors in the final classification in the same preceding Championships that Member may enter 3 competitors in total in the respective category. The host country is entitled to enter 3 Competitors in total in each category (though the minimum qualifying times as stated below do apply to the host country as well);

Minimum qualifying times are required for entry in this ISU Championship. The required qualifying times, the qualifying period, the category of competitions and other conditions under which the times must have been achieved, are decided by the Short Track Speed Skating Technical Committee and will be announced in an ISU Communication. The ISU Members are responsible to submit verification of the best qualifying time achieved by each Competitor entered for the ISU Championship. If sufficient verification is missing, the entry will not be accepted.

Reason: When the maximum number of skaters (3) from the organizing nation may always compete on the individual distances, this could have a positive effect on the attention and popularity of short track in the host country. The Relay competition already has a regulation to the benefit of the host country; this proposal expands this regulation to the individual distances.

NB. This proposal does NOT affect the number of starting positions of other nations. The starting positions for the skaters of the host nation will be additional.

Urgent Proposal No. 6

NETHERLANDS

Rule 290 paragraph 5.i)

Amend to read:

The Referee, at his discretion, before a decision is made, decides to view the Video Replay system at full speed, slow motion or still picture, with the exception of matters concerning the starting procedure. When the Referee decides to view the Video Replay system, before a decision is made, then the video footage concerned should also be shown on the screen in the stadium at the same time.

Reason: To be transparent and to make events and decisions during the competition more comprehensible for spectators, coaches and skaters etcetera. The video footage concerned should be available for the television networks as well.

特別規程 シングル&ペアスケート/アイスダンス

緊急提案 第7番

英国

規程第 378 条第 3 項, ISU 選手権大会シングル & ペア& アイスダンスへの参加申し込み

以下のように修正;

3. 最低総要素点:

ISU 選手権大会に申込みを行い参加するためには選手/ペア/カップルは ISU 認定の国際競技会(第 38 条第 7 節及び規則 107 条第 1-9 節による)で現在または直前のシーズンの間に申し込み可能な最低総要素点(ポイント)に到達していなければならない。申し込み可能な最低総要素点は各シーズンについて対応する技術委員会とスポーツ理事の共同提案に基づき ISU 理事会により決定されなければならない ISU コミュニケーションとして公表されなければならない。

理由: 総得点は ISU が選手/ペア/カップルの総合能力を評価するために使われる指標であり、従って選手/ペア/カップルの競技会及び選手権大会への参加資格として用いるのに最も適切な指標である。また総要素点は技術要素点のみを単独で用いるより技術的能力とプログラム構成のより良いバランスを反映する。

緊急提案 第 8 番

オランダ

規程第 415 条 – テクニカルスペシャリストの推薦と任命についての特定の要求
第 2 節 c) について以下のように修正:

セミナー参加: 推薦の暦年 7 月 31 日から 48ヶ月前までの間に, 国際テクニカルスペシャリスト最初の任命または再任命のための ISU セミナー(規程第 417 条参照)への参加を完了. (他は変更なし)

理由: コスト削減, ジャッジ及びレフェリーの再認証要求に合わせるため. また技術規程はわずかな顕著な変更の他はかなり安定になってきたためでもある.
